Steve Berry's distinguished career has taken him from the backwaters of the Northeast Kingdom of Vermont to Yale University where he was a Teaching Assistant to world famous author and spiritual teacher **Henri** J.M. Nouwen. He founded an inner-city Soup Kitchen, a model Interfaith Program, Film Forum, Art Gallery and a Learning Center. As the Senior Minister of the historic First Congregational Church of Los Angeles, CA (Pilgrim School and Cedar Lake Camp), he initiated Hands-Across-LA after the civil unrest. He became a leader with Habitat for Humanity and a chaplain in the LAPD. He has received numerous awards for his humanitarian work and activism including the United Nations Associations' Ralph Bunche Peace Award. He has made documentary films and has authored essays and books, including books with theologian Walter Wink and theoretical anthropologist René Girard. He teamed up with Human Rights Pioneer, Jack Healey to make VT the first state to adopt a resolution honoring the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. He led the VT initiative to Reverse Citizens United in 2013.
